BACKGROUND

Antimicrobial resistance (AMR), also known as the "silent pandemic," kills approximately 4.95 million people a year worldwide. Antimicrobial drugs are essential for the prevention of perioperative infections, and AMR could prevent society from enjoying safe and secure standard treatments such as cancer surgery. The impact of AMR has unfortunately spread to traditional infections, including drug-resistant tuberculosis and beyond infections. AMR must be addressed as a structural challenge to the healthcare system and a cross-disease problem in an aging society, which requires strong leadership from the state and the international community.

This event will discuss Japan's past contributions, prospects, and expectations regarding AMR measures. Through the discussions, we will explore ways countries can work together to realize the UNGA's Political Declaration on AMR, a complex and multifaceted issue involving healthcare, agriculture, the environment, the economy, industrial development, security, trade, and others. In support of the themes of the high-level meeting, it will also touch on the essential role of civil society in realizing the Political Declaration and national action plans.
